Lift Tickets on Race Day	\$12 for each team member racing in the meet, \$27 for each additional team member not racing in the finals. 2 comp. tickets will be issued per school for coaches. Teams are asked to contact Nub's Nob with their ticket requirements by 2-18-20. Please make checks payable to Nub's Nob. All other tickets are sold at regular rates and all tickets may be purchased at the ticket window between noon and 4pm Sunday 2-23-20 or at the ticket window at 7:30am on Monday 2-24-20
Lift Tickets Prior to Race	Team members who are racing in the MHSAA Finals competition and up to 2 of their coaches may purchase \$35 full day tickets on Saturday and Sunday prior to the State meet. These tickets must be purchased each day by the coach of each team as a group at the ticket window and the coach must provide a list of who the tickets are for. Also, have your release forms for your team or individual for ticket office when purchasing your tickets. All participants must have a ticket or race bib to ride the lifts.
Training lanes	** Weather Permitting** Training lanes will be provided Saturday 6pm-10pm and Sunday 9am-4pm. Training will be done by region, region lane assignments to follow. Training lanes will be on Scarface. Please contact KC McGovern at kcmcgovern@live.com for questions. Training lanes may be available on that Saturday, Saturday night and Sunday prior to the State Meet on Nub's Nob regular alpine training slopes, not on meets slopes, at no cost to teams.

Failure to do so may subject the team to an additional 5 points added to the team's score. Volunteer assignments will be assigned to each team. - 8:15 am Run order substitution deadline
- 7:45 am Chair Opens for Athlete Loading
- 8:15-8:45am **Courses open for inspection**

 - Jury observes racer course inspections.
 - Women's Slalom inspection by in and out Inspection only. (Unless requested by Jury)
 - Men's GS inspection in and out only. (Unless requested by Jury)

- Gate judges in place for Run #2 on GS and Slalom hills when inspection closes
- Forerunners for Run #2: Slalom skiers right, GS skiers right

Break and Reset after completion of morning race

No racers in Cedar Lounge

***NO COW Bells or load horns within 200 feet of the leaderboard**

Afternoon

Scratch deadline 30 minutes after finish of morning session (in Nubs Pub)

Courses open for inspection – 45 minutes after completion of morning session

- Jury observes course inspection (same as above)
- Men's slalom skiers left "In and Out" inspection only, unless specified by Jury
- Women's GS inspection skiers left In and Out inspection only, unless specified by Jury

Inspection closes 30 minutes after course inspection begins

- Gate judges in place for Run #1 on both GS and Slalom hills
- Forerunners Run #1 - Slalom skiers left, GS skiers left

Run #1 Starts 5 minutes after course inspection closes

- Run #1 starts for men Slalom and women GS
- Inspection for run #2 begins 5 minutes after completion of 1st Run

30 minutes after inspection begins

- Inspection Closes
- Gate judges in place for Run #2, both Slalom and GS hills
- Forerunners Run #2: Slalom skiers right, GS skiers right
- Run #2 starts for men and women

**DQ's will be posted after each flight is completed on the finish leader boards and will be posted until 15 minutes after the completion of each run. Protests must be made within 15 minutes after the completion of each run.
