12 LESSONS FROM #BOTF...

#1 Work With Your AD

- Work WITH, not against
- You might be able to more than you ever thought possible
- Schedule meetings, set expectations

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#2 Organize/ Communicate

- Leadership Team
- Facebook

- White board calendar

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#3 Creative Theme Nights

- Schedule season in advance
- Be creative
- Make sure everyone knows

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#4 Stay Positive

- -Not as hard as you think
- -Cheer for your team, not against others
- -Not the refs, not the opponents, not other student sections

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***5** Stay Loud

- From tip to the final horn
- Just because the players get a break, you don't
